## Membership Web Site Profile:

### **Entering CTSASA Competitions**

The CTSASA web site requires that a paid-up member uses their web site profile to login and then enter a competition. Only paid up CTSASA members can enter CTSASA Championships. The procedure is:

- 1. Ensure that you have your profile username and password (see below)
- 2. Go to the CTSASA web site and click on LOGIN at the middle of the top of the home page.
- 3. Enter your **username** (which is your **email address**)
- 4. Enter your password (given here unless previously supplied) : **«cpsa\_no»**
- 5. Click on 'NAVIGATE', then 'COMPETITIONS' and 'VIEW AND ENTER UPCOMING COMPETITIONS'.
- 6. Follow the prompts to enter your details.

# UNIQUE EMAIL ADDRESS IS REQUIRED FOR EACH MEMBER

Please note that the CTSASA web site requires unique email addresses for each member.

This is to ensure information is sent to the right address and to confirm competition entries.

Once logged in, please click on your name that appears on the black login button at the top of the screen. Scroll down and view the competitions you have entered. You can select to edit or delete your entries.

# Membership Web Site Profile: Updating personal details and requesting documents to support firearm licence applications
